STRESS IN DO / DOES

Do not stress the auxiliary do / does in yes / no questions.

For example:

Do you LIKE the SWEATER?

• • — • — •

Does he NEED a TIE?

• • — • —

Exercise 1 Read and practice.

Stress the auxiliary do / does in short answers and don't / doesn't in negative sentences.

For example:

He DOESn't NEED a TIE.

YES, he DOES.
