## Pronunciation Supplement (Unit 12)

### THE SOUND OF H

Drop the sound /h/ in unstressed words such as his, her. Link the final consonant sound of the verb to the vowel sound of his or her.

*For example:*

She burned d~~h~~er arm. = < She burn der arm. >

He hurt t~~h~~is shoulder. = < He hur tis shoulder. >

**Exercise 1** Listen to the Vocabulary on page 102 of the Student's Book and repeat after the pauses.

1. He burned d~~h~~is finger.
2. She hurt t~~h~~er back.
3. She cut t~~h~~er hand.
4. He broke k~~h~~is arm.

Pronounce the sound /h/ in stressed words.

*For example:*

head      hip      headache      hope      hear      happened
