**PRONUNCIATION OF UNSTRESSED WORDS**

Words that carry the most information in a sentence are usually stressed. These words are generally nouns, main verbs, possessive pronouns, adverbs, and adjectives.

Words such as articles, helping verbs, personal pronouns, and prepositions are unstressed.

For example:

I'm GOING to NEED a RENTAL CAR in DUBAI.  
WHAT DATE are you ARRIVING?
